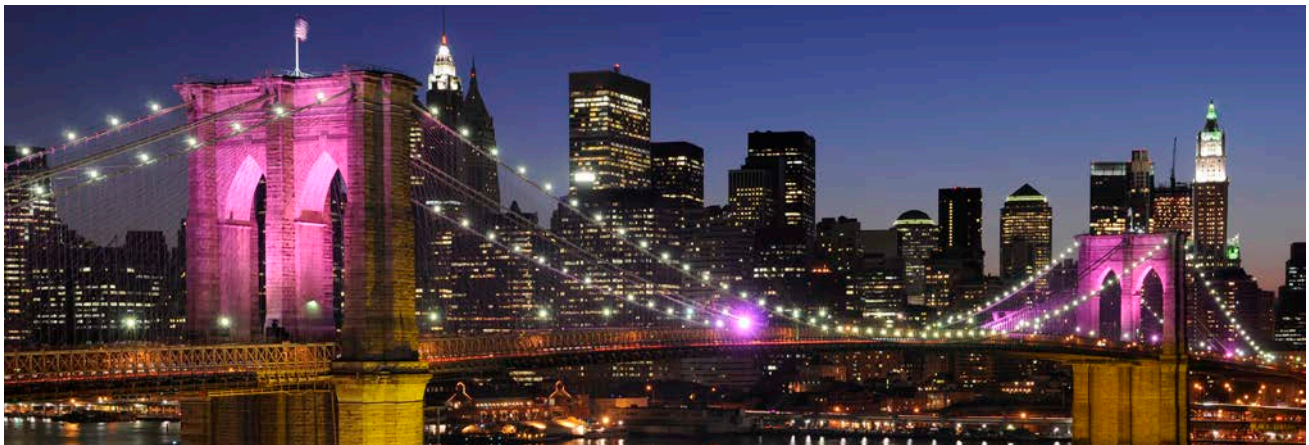

## New York Dining Cruises

## TV & Manhattan Movie Locations Tour

Be amazed at how many iconic television and movie moments were shot within a stone's throw of NBC Studios. In the company of a local guide, you'll visit the most important sites from the 9/11 attacks, including St. Peter's Church, the Oculus, and the FDNY Memorial Wall. Visit the 9/11 Memorial including the reflection pools and survivor tree, and hear first account stories of tragedy, heroism, and community cohesion from your dedicated guide. This tour also includes pre-reserved, skip-the-line tickets to the 9/11 Memorial Museum where you can spend time on your own.





## Wall Street Walking Tour

FROM NEW YORK CITY • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

Walk down the shortest street in the city, seek out the places that played a prominent role in the American Revolution and visit the site of the first presidential inauguration. Wall Street is famous as the center of global finance, but this guided walking tour will highlight the untapped history of this fascinating neighborhood. Explore the cobbled streets with a local guide and uncover areas like the old slave market, as well as current attractions like The Bull, New York Stock Exchange, Fearless Girl statue, Trinity Church, and Alexander Hamilton's Gravesite. See the remains of the 17th Century Lovelace Tavern and learn the secrets of Zuccotti Park.



## Grand Central Terminal Tour

FROM NEW YORK CITY • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

From secret staircases to a onetime movie theater, there's a lot more to Grand Central Terminal than meets the eye. Your tour begins in Grand Central Terminal's modern-day heart: the lively main concourse. Marvel at the famous clock perched atop the information booth as your guide regales you with the story of Cornelius Vanderbilt, the mastermind behind Grand Central. You'll head into Vanderbilt Hall, gaze at the largest Tiffany clock in the world and then travel back in time to the Roaring 20s into a speakeasy-style bar. The Whispering Gallery, the world's largest lost and found, Graybar Passage and Grand Central Market are also included.



## Statue of Liberty Express Tour - Museum & Statue Grounds

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

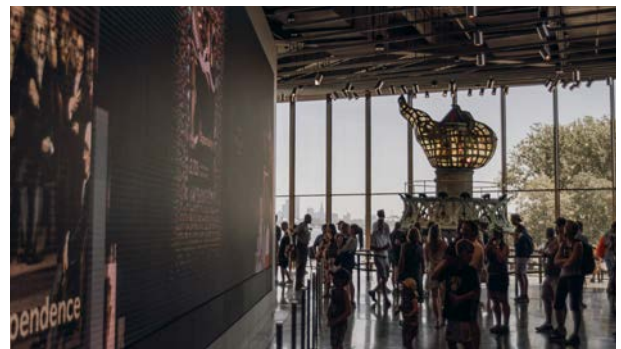
Your tour starts when you meet your expert guide in Battery Park and take in iconic buildings like Castle Clinton (America's first immigration station) and the Pier A Harbor House, before hopping a ferry out to the Statue of Liberty. When you arrive on the Island, you'll dive into the story of how the statue came to be and why it almost wasn't built at all. After a tour of the island, you'll board the ferry again and be back in Battery Park. In just three hours, you'll have seen the Statue and learned its story from an expert guide.



## Early Access Statue of Liberty VIP Tour & Ellis Island

FROM NEW YORK CITY • FOUR HOURS

Begin your day at The Battery – the historical gateway to Lady Liberty. Then, board the earliest ferry of the day (morning tour only), and sail away from Manhattan to greet the Statue of Liberty. It is here your guide will dive deep into the story of how Lady Liberty came to be. Take in beautiful views of the famed New York skyline, the Brooklyn Bridge, and the surrounding environs. Wander through the Statue of Liberty Museum and stand mere feet from Lady Liberty's original torch. Next, board for the short ferry ride to Ellis Island. Your guide sets the tone with a brief introduction and then you can explore this special place at your own pace.



## Private Full Day Highlights of New York City

FROM NEW YORK CITY • SEVEN HOURS

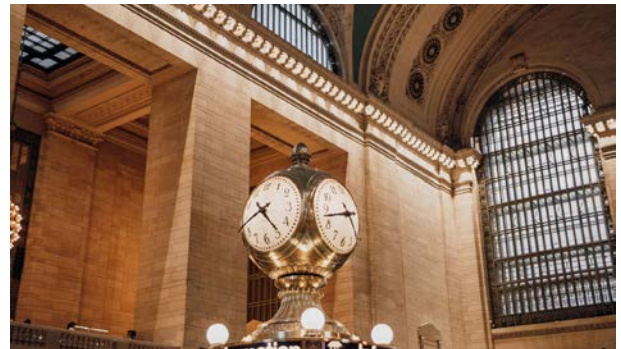
Explore the Big Apple – from the bustling streets of Downtown Manhattan to the serenity of Central Park. On your private tour of New York City, you will see the best sights of Downtown Manhattan, including Wall Street's Charging Bull, Fearless Girl, and the National 9/11 Memorial. Next, it's on to the bustle of Midtown, including tours of Grand Central Terminal and Times Square. You'll stroll through Central Park, seeing Strawberry Fields and Bethesda Terrace & Fountain. To finish your tour, you'll gaze out over the city from the Rockefeller Center.



## New York City Mafia & Food Private Tour

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

Get the insider's perspective on the infamous Mafia crime families of New York City on this walking and food tasting tour through the vibrant and fascinating gangland area of New York's East Village and Little Italy. If you're into criminal history, the Mafia, or gangsters, then this larger-than-life tour will more than deliver. You'll hear about the spying, the escapes, the hit men, drug running, double-crossing, criminality, and all the drama of this most sinister yet riveting world of gangsters, while also indulging in delicious Italian food at some of the city's best joints.



## Private Walking Tour of Midtown with Empire State Tickets

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

With many of the city's most famous sights, Midtown Manhattan is one of the best places to experience the spirit of New York. On your private tour, you will stroll glamorous Fifth Avenue to gaze at the world-famous window displays, marvel at Neo-Gothic St Patrick's Cathedral which has been the city's beacon of Catholicism since 1878. Next admire some of Manhattan's most beautiful Art Deco structures, like the Rockefeller building, before stepping into the bright neon lights of Times Square. Learn about the city's rich architectural history, seeing the classics including the Chrysler Building, the Flatiron Building, and Grand Central Terminal and finish with jaw-dropping views from the top of the Empire State Building.



## Central Park Walking Tour with a Private Guide

FROM NEW YORK CITY • TWO HOURS

A green haven in the heart of Manhattan, Central Park is a great place to escape the city. On your private walking tour of Central Park, you will stroll down the iconic Mall, which includes the newly erected monument to the Women's March, and statues to literary figures including Shakespeare and Robert Burns. You'll also see the statue dedicated to Balto, the sled dog which helped bring life-saving medicine to children in Alaska. During the two hours you'll visit several iconic places in the park, including Bethesda Terrace and Bethesda Fountain, and see famous filming locations. You finish your tour at one of the most visited spots – Strawberry Fields – where you too can pay tribute to John Lennon.





## Private Tour of Little Italy, Soho, Greenwich Village & Chinatown

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

The different neighbourhoods of New York each have something to give the curious traveller. On this tour you will visit four of its most vibrant districts to see many of New York's off-the-beaten-path sights, all accompanied by a private guide, giving you the history of these famous and disparate neighbourhoods. The tour begins in the avant-garde Greenwich Village, to see where the Friends flat allegedly was, and the Washington Arch. Learn about the Stonewall Riots, and see the Monument dedicated to it. Visit the artistic soul of New York City in Soho, filled with galleries and art museums. And finally, see the impact of immigration in Little Italy and Chinatown.



## Private Full Day Tour of the Statue of Liberty & Midtown

FROM NEW YORK CITY • EIGHT HOURS

Enjoy a full day exploring with a private guide. You'll have priority entry into the Liberty Island Ferry Facility, and see the Statue of Liberty up close, learning of her remarkable history and significance to modern America. Explore Ellis Island and witness breathtaking views of the Manhattan skyline from the water. Back on land, you'll stand in the centre of Times Square, discover the theatre district, and admire some of Manhattan's most beautiful Art Deco structures, like the Rockefeller building, and Lawrie's statue of Atlas. Finally, after walking Fifth Avenue to gaze at the world-famous window displays, your tour ends with a visit to the Top of the Rock for impressive views over the city.



## Iconic Architecture, Private Tour of The Big Apple

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

Since its founding 400 years ago, New York City has been in a constant state of construction, with the Big Apple's iconic skyline evolving yearly. On your private architectural tour, you will visit the most renowned areas, buildings, and streets of the Big Apple. Of course, you'll see the illustrious skyscrapers like the Chrysler and the 102-story Art Deco Empire State Building, which was the world's tallest building for nearly 40 years. But, not all of New York City's 700,000 buildings touch the clouds. You will also discover lesser-known buildings and areas and learn the backstories of the Big Apple's pioneering architecture, the people, and the politics that made it happen.



## The Statue of Liberty & Ellis Island with a Private Guide

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

See New York from a different perspective on a tour that takes you out to the islands in Upper Bay. With visits to both the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island, you will be able to see New York as so many immigrants did, before they helped grow the wealth and history of America. At the museum, your expert local guide will talk you through some of the exhibits on display. You'll also hear about the fascinating history of the Liberty figure, and how this 100th birthday gift from France was shipped from Paris and finally unveiled in 1886 after 10 years of construction.
