Portland Helicopter Tours

FROM PORTLAND • MULTIPLE DURATIONS

Gorgeously framed between forested hills and broad rivers, Portland from the air is a treat for the eye. We have three tour options for you to choose from, both sure to delight you from the minute you board the helicopter. Better yet, you'll depart from a rooftop landing pad right in the heart of downtown Portland. Transportation to the landing pad is not included.



Flightseeing Air Tours

FROM TROUTDALE (PORTLAND AREA) • MULTIPLE DURATIONS

These incredible air tours are a wonderful addition to your stay in Portland. Taking off from Troutdale, twenty minutes from downtown Portland, you have a choice of six tour routes; Wonderful Waterfalls, Vista View, Experience Multnomah, The Portlandia, Quicksand Triangle and The Figure Eight. Each offers an amazing array of scenic viewpoints, and includes between twenty minutes and one hour in the sky. Transportation to the airfield is not included.



Haunted Pub Tour

FROM PORTLAND • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

On this spine-tingling walking tour, you'll uncover Portland's dark side. In the early 1900s, unsuspecting sailors were often ruthlessly abducted and whisked away through the notorious Shanghai Tunnels. You'll be entertained with stories of how notorious criminals kidnapped thousands of people and why their ghosts still haunt Portland today. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



FROM PORTLAND • EIGHT HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

This Mt. Hood Loop tour offers a fun and stress-free way to see the top sites near Portland, including the nationally recognised Multnomah Falls, Columbia River Gorge, Hood River Valley, and Timberline Lodge. Portland City Tour

Not only will you experience the best landmarks, including International Rose Garden, Pioneer Courthouse Square, Tilikum Crossing, Lake Oswego, Willamette Falls, the Oregon City Municipal Elevator, and downtown Oregon City but you will also learn what makes the citizens of these areas so diversified, and learn the cultural history of these unique Pacific Northwest towns. Portland City Tour & Gorge Waterfalls Combo

FROM PORTLAND • EIGHT HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Experience the most popular tour of Portland combined with a journey out to the Columbia River Gorge. Portland Bike Tour

FROM PORTLAND • TWO HOURS

Take a spin around the City of Roses on this bike tour of essential Portland. Pedal through the city's historic Old Town, along the river on the Waterfront Esplanade, through the Park Blocks with their many green spaces and the hip Pearl District. Learn about the spirit of Portland from knowledgeable guides as you see the city as many of the locals do—by bike. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Hike and Bike: Columbia River Gorge Hidden Waterfalls

FROM PORTLAND • FOUR HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Combine hiking and bicycling on this small-group tour of the Columbia River Gorge, ideal for active travellers. After a minivan ride from Portland to the Gorge, you'll hop on your bike and start exploring, stopping at the Vista House, Bridal Veil Falls and Multnomah Falls along the way. You'll also visit Latourell Falls, where you'll take a hike along a 2.1-mile loop trail up to the lower falls. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.

Portland Food Carts, Pods & Patios Tour

FROM PORTLAND • THREE HOURS

Portland is known for its food carts, but with numerous pods across the city, it can be difficult to know where to start. With this tour, your group will head to one of the city's oldest food cart pods, where you'll get the chance to try treats from five to seven different food carts plus a brewery. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.





Portland Segway Tour

FROM PORTLAND • TWO HOURS

Zip through Portland's historic and developing west-side neighbourhoods on this guided Segway tour. Select a one and a half hour waterfront tour or a two hour historical downtown tour, and enjoy quality sightseeing aboard your electric Segway. Visit locations like the Steel Bridge, Pearl District, historic Chinatown and the Portland Art Museum for a window into the city's industrial and cultural past. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Portland Dining Cruises

FROM PORTLAND • TWO HOURS

One of the nicest ways to dine in Portland is on the Willamette River, enhanced by dazzling city sights and lights. You'll enjoy a two hour cruise, either a lunch, brunch or three-course dinner with Northwest cuisine (locally sourced and prepared fresh on board), live piano music and narration of the sights from the outer decks. This is a quintessential Portland experience. Transportation to the harbour is not included.



Bigfoot Adventure Cruise

FROM PORTLAND • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Explore the history and lore of Bigfoot while traveling 80 miles roundtrip on a high-speed jetboat from Portland to Multnomah Falls. See the landmarks along the Willamette and Columbia Rivers that make the Northwest famous, while listening to exclusive narration from a tour guide. You'll enjoy curated information about the legend of Bigfoot and sightings in the Columbia River Gorge on this exhilarating journey. Transportation to the harbour is not included.



7 Wonders of the Gorge Cruise

FROM PORTLAND • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Experience some of the most majestic views of the lower Columbia River Gorge visible by water aboard the Explorer. You'll travel under several famous bridges on your round-trip journey from Portland to Multnomah Falls and enjoy the unique views of the Willamette River and the mighty Columbia River. Sights include Cape Horn, Multnomah Falls, Crown Point, Rooster Rock, Beacon Rock, Mount Hood and, of course, the Columbia River. A tour guide will provide narration of the sights as you travel. Transportation to the harbour is not included.



Willamette Valley Wine & Waterfalls Private Tour

FROM PORTLAND • NINE HOURS

After departing from Portland, you'll start your morning in Oregon's largest state park, Silver Falls, walking with your guide along peaceful nature trails. Venture along a path that takes you behind the falls, where you can watch the water create a flowing curtain for the cave you're standing in! In the afternoon you'll be tasting pinot noirs and other fine wines in the intimate settings of three boutique wineries. In between tastings, you'll enjoy Oregon's culinary bounty with a fresh, local lunch at the Coelho Winery in the rustic town of Amity. Pick up available from selected downtown Portland hotels.



Mt. St Helens National Monument Private Tour

FROM PORTLAND • TWELVE HOURS

This beautiful journey takes you into the heart of Mt. Saint Helen's National Volcanic Monument. You'll witness the ecosystems recovering and the on-going natural restoration process surrounding the active volcano. Just miles from the crater you can view the steaming caldera then head out with your naturalist guide on a walk to learn about how volcanoes are monitored and the geological events surrounding the catastrophic 1980 eruption. The tour includes morning tea and coffee, a family-style lunch and afternoon snacks and refreshments. Pick up available from selected downtown Portland hotels.



Explore Portland Private Tour

FROM PORTLAND • FOUR HOURS

Experience the sights, sounds and flavours of Portland on this half-day guided tour. You'll be taken around both the famous and lesser-known areas of the city, from the hip downtown and Pearl district to its eclectic neighbourhoods. You'll visit some of the city's iconic landmarks including the International Rose Test Garden, Mt. Tabor Park and Powell's Bookstore. Pick up available from selected downtown Portland hotels.



FROM PORTLAND • SIX HOURS

This half day trip takes you to two great attractions of the Pacific Northwest – the Columbia River Gorge and Oregon wine. Leaving your Portland hotel, you'll travel in a luxury van with a professional tour guide. You'll learn about the magnificent gorge and spot wildlife on a guided hike, before visiting boutique Oregon wineries and learning the art of viticulture. Pick up available from selected downtown Portland hotels.





Baker City Walking & Tasting Tour

FROM BAKER CITY • TWO HOURS

Walk between the historical sites of Baker City, on this immersive self-guided sightseeing tour, which makes a great choice for first-time visitors and history buffs. This historic tour is delivered straight to your mobile device (phone, tablet, or computer) and includes a map, GPS locator, and extensive written, audio, and visual content, leaving you to explore historic Baker City at your own pace. Learn the history, from its early days as a mining boomtown to modern-day, and unlock exclusive discounts at some local establishments. Transportation is not included.



Jet Boat Aventure

FROM HELLS CANYON • FIVE HOURS

This adventure through the Wild River section features the biggest rapids on the river, the deepest depths of the canyon, and the most jaw-dropping scenery transitions throughout — you can expect to see rock walls, desert grasslands and alpine forests all on the same trip. Listen to captains as they regale you with stories about the early Native Americans who inhabited this area and the ranching families that called Hells Canyon home. Keep your eyes open for wildlife such as bald eagles, black bears, and bighorn sheep. Transportation to the launch site is not included.



Whitewater Rafting With Jet Boat Return

FROM HELLS CANYON • SEVEN HOURS

Hells Canyon is the deepest gorge in North America, and at the bottom of it roils some of the biggest Whitewater in the region. During your rafting adventure, you'll admire the spectacular scenery of this wild canyon while learning about the history of the area. The professional and experienced guides will help you understand this part of the West, and serve up a great lunch too. Transportation to the launch site is not included.



Underground Tour

FROM PENDLETON • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

No Oregon town has a more colourful history! Find out why Pendleton was known as the entertainment capital of Eastern Oregon. This is where the past becomes real. Follow your guide underground on this ninety minute tour, to the Shamrock Card Room, Hop Sing's (Chinese Laundry), the Empire Ice Cream Parlour, through the tunnels beneath the sidewalks to the Empire Meat Market. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Horseback Riding Beach Trail

FROM FLORENCE • MULTIPLE DURATIONS

Begin with a ride through forest and wetlands toward the sound of pounding surf and the smell of salt air. Suddenly, you are over a sand dune and on the beach for a breathtaking ride where you can walk or trot your horse. Ride lengths vary from one to two hours. Transportation to the stables are not included.



Sand Dunes Frontier

FROM FLORENCE • THIRTY MINUTES

Some of the world's largest and most beautiful dunes are located on the Central Oregon Coast. Glistening valleys, vast hills of shifting sand, and desert atmosphere make the dunes truly a must-see. Leaving the driving to the skilled guides, the sand rail tour is for the adrenaline seekers. Young and old alike enjoy this exhilarating Dune Buggy ride which includes twelve miles of rolling dunes. Transportation to the dunes is not included.



Kayaking Brookings Chetco River

FROM BROOKINGS • TWO HOURS

A kayak tour on the wild and scenic Chetco River estuary in Brookings offers a variety of sightings, including pelicans, kingfishers, seals and sloughs as well as some of the cleanest water on the coast. The boat basin provides a very easy, calm water introduction, among your fellow sailers ranging from commercial fishing boats and Coast Guard vessels to pleasure craft moored up by the docks. The route is two and a half miles long which takes up to two hours to navigate. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Ocean Kayaking Experience

FROM BROOKINGS • TWO HOURS

This is a great introductory to ocean kayaking, whilst offering more advanced options for those more experienced paddlers. From the boat basin it is easy access to the Pacific Ocean, where large kelp forests and a rocky habitat await. Gray whales are fairly common and Harbor Seals are the norm on this two hour tour which covers around four miles of water. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Santiam Whitewater Rafting

FROM MILL CITY • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Enjoy the thrill of whitewater on this six mile section of the river made up of class II+ rapids with four class IIIs. It takes about two and a half hours to complete and is a great way to enjoy some splashy fun through adrenaline-pumping rapids. Although adventurous, this is still suitable for beginners and families, with a choice of raft or inflatable kayak for your experience. Transportation to the launch site is not included.



Oregon Wine Country Experience By Bike

FROM HOOD RIVER • FIVE HOURS

Located outside of Portland, the Columbia River Gorge is home to an abundance of orchards, vineyards, and sweeping views of Mt. Adams and Mt. Hood. On this guided tour, you can choose to explore the area by bike or e-bike. Stop at three local wineries for vineyard tours, tastings, and locally sourced fresh-food pairings. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Santiam River Rafting

FROM MILL CITY • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

This seven mile section of the river is made up of class I-II+ rapids and takes about two and a half hours to complete. Guides will give you a great introduction to river paddling on this pristine Oregon river. This section of aquamarine-coloured water takes you past the Santiam State Park, and lots of scenic viewpoints. This river rafting is perfect for beginner kayakers, rafters, and families who just want a relaxing scenic float. Transportation to the launch site is not included.



Take a tour of the Willamette Valley, for a taste of this regions incredible products, ranging from cheese and fresh vegetables to olive oil. Next, you'll get to meet the dedicated farmers that make them! On this tour, you will stop at three or four hand-selected farms, based on seasonality of the produce. Pick up available from Beaverton or Tillamook.





Willamette Falls Kayak or Paddleboard Tour

FROM OREGON CITY • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

Paddle through the stunning landscape of the historic Oregon Trail as you make your way to the second-largest waterfall in the United States. Whether you are an experienced paddler or not, this trip has something for everyone. You will paddle through waters rich with fish, herons, osprey, and sea lions, dependent on the season. The tour heads one mile upstream, passing by the historic Willamette Falls Locks, en route to Willamette Falls at the end of the Oregon Trail. Choose to take your adventure by paddleboard or kayak. Transportation to the launch site is not included.



Chehalem Valley Cycle Tour

FROM NEWBERG • SIX HOURS HOURS

This guided wine tour by bike, takes approximately six hours. You will pedal through the gorgeous Chehalem Valley to three wineries. The terrain consists of mainly flat roads, which may include some gravel depending on the route, along with some "Oregon-style" rolling hills. You will ride at a leisurely pace, stopping frequently to enjoy the sights and learn about this beautiful region, its wines, history, and anything else you may be interested in. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Champoeg State Park Wine Cycle Tour

FROM NEWBERG • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

On this cycle tour ride, you will cover between eight and ten miles on paved park bike paths and quiet forest roads. Historic Champoeg State Park is located along the beautiful Willamette River, an area highly regarded for its wine-producing quality. A picnic lunch at Lady Hill Winery is included. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



FROM GRANTS PASS • MULTIPLE DURATIONS

The Rogue River in Southern Oregon is one of America's top whitewater rafting and kayaking destinations due to its incredible scenery, rapids, wildlife, and amazing riverside lodges. Choose between a full or half day Rogue River Hellgate Canyon Raft Tour, or Rogue River Thrill Seeker which combines river kayaking with white water rafting. Tours range from four to ten hours. Transportation to the launch is not included.
