FROM TORONTO • SIX HOURS

The six hour Gems of Toronto City Tour, provides an immersive, intimate, insiders view of the city, with visits to Toronto's most popular sights as well as many hidden gems. The CN Tower, Yorkville, Kensington Market, St Lawrence Market, Sugar Beach, Royal Ontario Museum, Casa Loma and the Distillery and Theatre districts are all on the schedule. Whirlpool Jet Boat Tours

Take a scenic and exhilarating ride down Niagara Gorge and the white water of Devils Hole Rapids to the Whirlpool, just a half mile from the tumbling rapids of Niagara Falls. Departing from Niagara-on-the-Lake or Niagara Falls, the enclosed Jet Dome boat thrills its passengers on the bouncy ride, but the more adventurous must try the Wet Jet with added splash! Wet Jet is exceptional, but not suited to those who cannot swim or hold their breath. Transportation to the launch sites not included.



Algonquin Group Paddle Day Trip

FROM ALGONOUIN PARK • SIX HOURS

The guided adventure navigates into the secluded corners of Algonquin Park. Paddle historic Canoe Lake, cross an easy 300 m portage and enjoy a lakeside meal (included). Cliff jumping (optional), a short 1.8 km hike to a panoramic lookout and picking wild berries during their respective season are also included. The guide will teach basic canoeing skills, the history of the park, and introduce you to the flora and fauna. Transportation to the park is not included.



Algonquin Motorised Canoe Trip

FROM ALGONQUIN PARK • THREE HOURS

This motorised canoe tour takes two passengers on a guided exploration of the park interior. The trip is split 90% motor and 10% paddling – perfect for those who want to relax or have their hands free for photography or sketching. You may choose a tractor-pulled wagon ride between May and October or a walking tour with a chance to stand in the vines and see how cranberries grow. Then you will taste award-winning wines on the tutored Muskoka Lakes Winery tour. Transportation to the farm is not included



Path of the Paddle, Haliburton Canoe Experience

FROM HALIBURTON (MUSKOKA REGION) • SIX HOURS

Carve a paddle through the still waters on Margaret, Dan, Horse, and McEwen Lakes. On this full day guided canoe trip you will discover the backcountry beauty of the Highlands, practice your paddle strokes, portage a canoe, learn some canoe tripping tips, go for a noon hour swim, stop at an impressive waterfall and visit a canoe builder who crafts birch bark canoes. This trip is well suited to the both the novice and experienced canoeist.. The adventure begins at Haliburton Forest & Wildlife Reserve and transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Introduction To Foraging, Wild Edible Mushrooms

FROM HALIBURTON (MUSKOKA REGION) • THREE HOURS

This immersive wilderness experience will bring you into the forest with a single delicious goal in mind: how to identify, find, and harvest wild edible mushrooms. There are thousands of species of mushrooms in eastern North America, many of which you can find in the Haliburton Highlands. Mushroom hunting is a fascinating, gratifying, and often misunderstood outdoor activity. You will learn the basics of foraging for these fungal wonders of nature. A snack, beverage and bush lunch is included. Your tour commences on the outskirts of Haliburton and transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Adventure Raft Trip

FROM FORESTERS FALLS (ONTARIO HIGHLANDS) • SIX HOURS

Northwest of the nation's capital, the Ottawa River surges across Canadian Shield country. This is a path forged by First Nations, traversed by fur traders since the 1600s and fostered by foresters at the turn of the last century. Today you can visit for a rafting adventure. Six hours of natural roller-coaster thrills, paddling as a team, getting wet, laughing and making new friends on the legendary 12km section of warm whitewater called the 'Rocher Fondu'! Enjoy body surfing and cliff jumping in the warm waters of the Ottawa River.



Soft Adventure Raft Trip

FROM FORESTERS FALLS (ONTARIO HIGHLANDS) • SIX HOURS

No experience is necessary on this low intensity fun adventure. You will experience a great Canadian river trip as an introduction to whitewater. Paddling as a team, your experienced guide steers from the stern — all you have to do is listen for directions, join in and have fun. Each rapid on the Ottawa is followed by a 'pool', giving you time to relax and prepare for the next one. You'll stop for a snack and maybe some cliff-jumping and before you know it, you meet the Pontoon boat, where you'll climb aboard for a hearty hot barbecued meal on the return cruise.



Lady Dive Amphibus Tour

FROM OTTAWA • ONE HOUR

Climb aboard the amphibus, a boat with wheels that can travel on both land and water, and enjoy a guided tour of Canada's capital. View over 75 historic sites of Ottawa-Gatineau by land and water. Be entertained by the tour conductors as they combine colourful anecdotes, humourous stories and historical information, into a fast moving, fully-narrated journey. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Ottawa Hop-on Hop-off Tour

FROM OTTAWA • TWENTY FOUR OR FORTY EIGHT HOUR TICKET

Take a tour of Ottawa, with the convenience of alighting and reboarding wherever you choose. On this hop-on hop-off sightseeing tour you will explore the Parliament Buildings, embassies, universities and museums. Haunted Walks of Ottawa

Choose from three great haunted tour options - each one chilling to the core. The Original Haunted Walk shares some of the city's favourite ghost stories and leads you by candellingt to some of its most haunted spots including the Bytown Museum and Ottawa high school. Ghosts and Gallows takes you inside the old Carleton County Jail, thought to be one of the most haunted buildings in North America. Crime and Punishment Historical Tour is also set in the Jail, but concentrates in the history. How was it used, what were the living conditions, did inmates escape? . Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Interzip Rogers, Ottawa Zipline

FROM OTTAWA • ONE HOUR

Take a thrilling zipline ride over the Ottawa River between Ontario and Quebec – the first and only zipline in the world that connects two provinces! Interzip Rogers takes you on a panoramic journey 37 metres over the Ottawa River at speeds of up to 40 kph. Soar along one of two parallel ziplines that run 425 m between Zibi properties on both sides of the river, just west of downtown Ottawa and Gatineau. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Rideau Canal Cruise

FROM OTTAWA • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

The Rideau Canal is a chain of beautiful lakes, rivers and canals winding 202 km from Kingston, at the head of Lake Ontario, to Ottawa, Canada's capital city. Discover the region, its history and rich cultural heritage while cruising on board North America's largest 100% electric passenger vessel, which is the only one of its kind. Transportation to the Ottawa dock is not included.



Ottawa River Cruise

FROM OTTAWA • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

Take a cruise along the Ottawa River, surrounded by the natural beauty of the region and some fantastic cityscapes as you weave your way down the Ottawa River. Kingston 1000 Islands Cruises

FROM KINGSTON • THREE HOURS

There is also a three hour lunch cruise, a three hour sunset dinner cruise and a shorter one hour discovery cruise. Transportation to the dock is not included.
